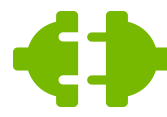

Open-source and social media driven community development

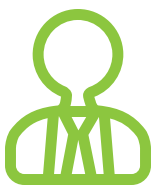


Consumer-level access to tools of development and creation
